The average offer was \$55,625.

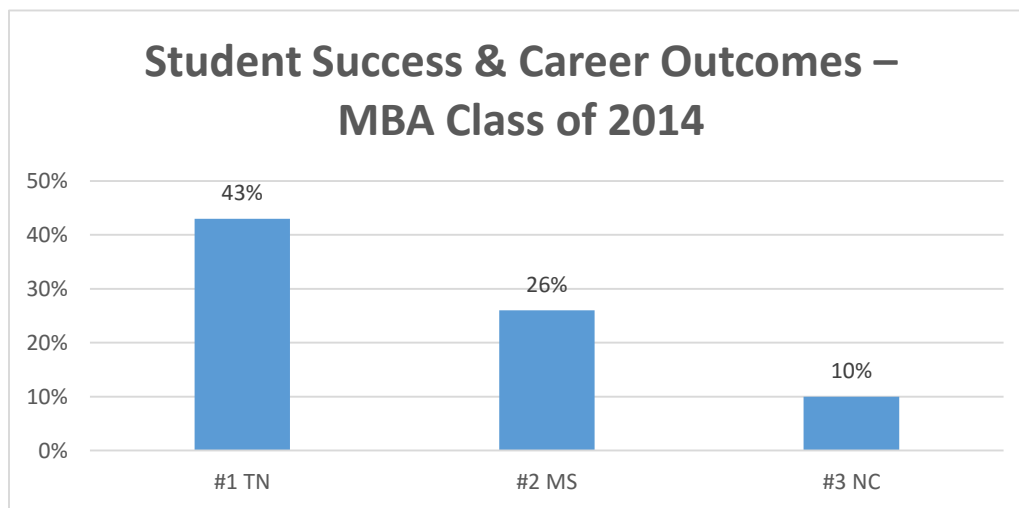

In a recent survey, we collected the following data:

- 67% of students utilized the campus Career Center in their job search
- 33% of students reached out to family members and 56% used a friend to find a job
- 22% of students credit the MBA Alumni Board for success in their job search
- On average students went on 4 interviews and applied to 67 jobs.
